Prizes

1st Place **Diamond** (CHF 2'000.– VKP), 2nd Place 900 CHF, 3rd Place 600 CHF, 4th Place 400 CHF, 5th Place 300 CHF, 6th Place 200 CHF, 7th Place 100 CHF.

Special prizes: Best Senior, Best Woman, Best Junior Under 18 (2006 and younger), under 2000 TWZ, under 1800 TWZ CHF 100 each if 5 or more participants per category.

CHF 5'000.– Total prize fund.

Prizes are not cumulative and are guaranteed if at least 80 paying participants take part.

Eligibility

- ▶ Open to all players with a FIDE ID.
- ▶ If you do not yet have a FIDE ID, please contact us as soon as possible.
- ▶ Attendance control: All participants must confirm their attendance at the tournament office on Friday, May 17, 2024, between 09:30 a.m and 11:30 a.m.

Entry Fee

Free entry for GM, IM, WGM and WIM. Payment in advance Adults 110 CHF, Juniors (2006 and younger) 70 CHF. +10 CHF on tournament day with cash payment

Laws of chess

- ▶ The FIDE rules and the corresponding regulations on <https://www.swisschess.ch/reglemente.html> apply
- ▶ Draw offers are only allowed from the 20th move.
- ▶ All categories are rated for the Swiss and the FIDE rating list.
- ▶ It is possible to take a bye until the 5th round (no game with half point. Buchholz with a strike result). The bye must be communicated to the tournament director before the end of the previous round at the latest (for the 1st round, Monday, 11.30 a.m. by e-mail or on site).

Miscellaneous

- ▶ The first boards will be transmitted online with a 10-minute delay.
- ▶ Late show-ups of up to 30 minutes from the start of the round will be tolerated. Anyone who arrives later at the board will lose the game forfeit - except in cases of force majeure.
- ▶ It is forbidden to bring electronic devices such as cell phones or smart watches into the playing hall. Devices can be deposited at the tournament office.
- ▶ Accompanying persons, coaches and spectators must remain outside the playing hall.
- ▶ In accordance with the FIDE Anti-Cheating Guidelines, a suitable detector is available in the playing hall.
- ▶ The latest version of SwissManager will be used to determine the draw. Games and results will be published on chess-results.com.
- ▶ In case of discrepancies, the German version of the tournament regulations applies.

Meals

The organizer offers lunch and dinner on site. Vouchers have to be ordered at the time of registration or afterwards (up to 1 week before the tournament).

Declaration of consent

By participating in the tournament, each player automatically agrees to the recording of images and their further use. The personal registration details collected will be processed exclusively for participation in the tournament. The following information will be published in the start, ranking and ranking lists: First name/last name, association, FIDE ID and year of birth.
